What is Indiana EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNT?

INDIANA EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNT (ESA), funded by state tax dollars, provides education options for K-12 students with a disability, and income at or below the annual income qualification.

ESA funding can be used on private school tuition, homebased education, therapies, tutoring, and more.



Student ELIGIBILITY

- + Resident of Indiana
- + 5-22 Years-old; K-12 grade level
- + Must have a disability and require special education through an Individualized Education Program (IEP), Service Plan (SP), or ESA Service Plan (ESA SP).
- + Income at or below income qualification (\$166,500 for a family of four)

Qualified ESA EXPENSES

- Private school tuition/fees
- Homebased education
- Testing and examination services
- Tutoring
- Educational camp
- Equestrian therapy
- Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services
- Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) services
- Other services provided by approved providers
