### What is Indiana

## **EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNT?**

INDIANA EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNT (ESA), funded by state tax dollars, provides education options for K-12 students with a disability, and income at or below the annual income qualification.

ESA funding can be used on private school tuition, homebased education, therapies, tutoring, and more.

#### Student

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Resident of Indiana
- + 5-22 Years-old; K-12 grade level
- Must have a disability and require special education through an Individualized Education Program (IEP), Service Plan (SP), or ESA Service Plan (ESA SP).
- Income at or below income qualification (\$166,500 for a family of four)
